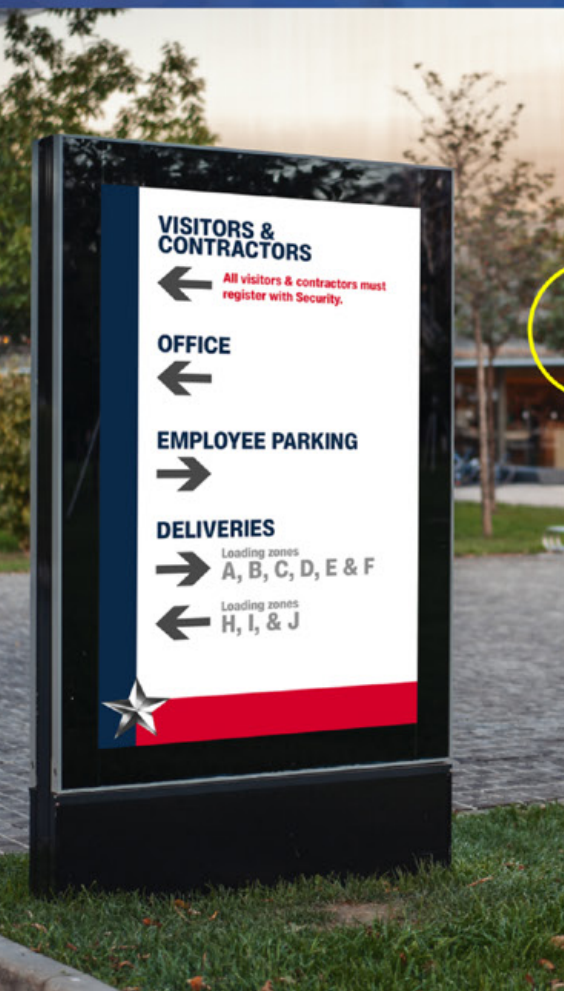

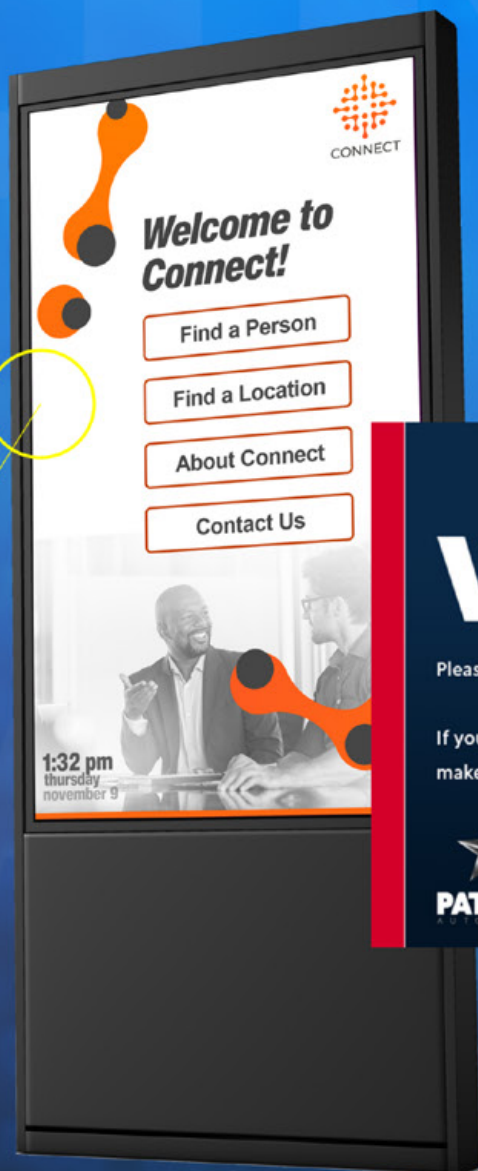


**OUR FIRST DAY OF

EMERGENCY NOTIFICATION

Keep employees and visitors safe during an emergency.

Digital signs provide a way to get real-time alerts and information to fans during an emergency. Combine existing audio alarms with visual emergency notifications to improve your disaster preparedness and safety plans.

Visual Emergency Notifications

Audio alarms are still necessary, but integrating digital signage with your audio alarms allows you to share crucial supplemental information. For example, highlight the type of emergency and location, so all relevant staff sees the message in addition to hearing it. In addition, share visual directions, meeting points, and other vital details.

Interrupt Scheduled Content

Interrupt content on screens in a specific area or department or your entire facility with important emergency information. Once the emergency is over, screens can quickly revert to their original content playlist.
